The goal of this program is to teach attendees lead-safe work practices and the strategies for implementing them. Many homes built before 1978 contain lead-based paint, so it is important that renovation, remodeling and repair activities use methods that reduce and control dust and debris created during work. Even a small amount of dust can pose a serious health risk to children and families.

These Lead Safe Work Practices trainings are based on EPA's and HUD's previous model courses in lead-safe work practices. This course satisfies HUD requirements for interim controls training in federally assisted housing.

Beginning in April 2010, contractors performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination. **The LSWP training is a pre-requisite to the RRP training.**
